Campus living is a once-in-a-lifetime experience that often leads to lifelong friendships. With your food cooked, sport and recreational facilities nearby, and being a short walk to classes, it is a safe and fun way to move away from home for the first time.

There are different types of accommodation and meal options on the Lake Macquarie campus.

ON-CAMPUS MEALS

Affectionately known as 'The Caf', our on-campus cafeteria provides cooked meals within a package for residential students, and pay-per-meal options for day students. Students can also buy light meals, snacks and drinks at Rejuve, our on-campus cafe.

ON-CAMPUS RESIDENTIAL

On-campus residential, dorm-style living in Watson (male residential living) or in Ella Boyd (female residential living) Halls. For students aged 17 to 25, both residential halls have spacious rooms with a bed and mattress, wardrobe and cupboards, desk and chair. Bathrooms, laundry and basic cooking facilities are shared. Students pay to occupy their room only during semester times and accommodation costs include wifi, water and electricity.

ACCOMMODATION

On-campus residential, dorm-style accommodation is available in separate men's and women's residences. Both residences have rooms with a bed and mattress, wardrobe and cupboards, desk and chair. Bathrooms, laundry and cooking facilities are all shared. Mature age students, other nurses and healthcare workers also live in the residences. Students can pay to occupy their room for shorter periods of time or for the year (at a discounted cost). Accommodation costs include water, electricity and the use of shared kitchens.

Meals are available on a pay-as-you-eat basis from the Sydney Adventist Hospital cafeteria.

WHAT DOES IT ALL MEAN?

It can be confusing to understand the terms universities use to talk about what they offer. Here are some important definitions that may be helpful to you.

UNDERGRADUATE/ UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE

An undergraduate degree is your first university award such as a bachelor's degree. The term is also used to describe a student enrolled in such a course, e.g., 'undergraduate student'.

UNIT OF STUDY

A unit is the university equivalent to a 'subject' in school, and is the smallest stand-alone component of a course that can be recorded on your academic transcript.

CREDIT POINT

The value that each unit of study contributes towards the completion of your course is known as a 'credit point'. At Avondale, most units of study are worth six credit points.

MAJOR/SPECIALISATION

Majors and specialisations are sequences of units (or subjects) that develop your skills in a field of study. A major is made up of six to eight units, while a specialisation is made up of 10 to 12 units of similar subject matter. Depending on your course of study, you will usually choose one major or specialisation, and one or two minors.

MIND

A minor is a sequence of units that develops your expertise in a field of study. A minor is usually made up of four units of similar subject matter. Depending on your course of study, you may choose a major and a minor, or a major and two minors.

SEMESTER

A semester is the academic teaching period; about 15 weeks long. At Avondale, our two semesters run from March to June, and from August to November.

DOMESTIC/ International student

You are considered a *domestic* student if you are:

An Australian or New Zoaland citizen (including

An Australian or New Zealand citizen (including dual citizen)

A permanent resident of Australia

All other students are considered *international* students.

FEE-HELP

FEE-HELP is a loan that Australian university students can take to help pay part or all of their tuition fees. It does not cover costs like accommodation, laptops or textbooks and it can be paid back to the government through the taxation system later. For more information, visit studyassist.gov.au.

TUTORIAL

Tutorials, or 'tutes', provide students with an opportunity to ask their lecturer questions and talk about course materials with fellow students. Most units of study have a lecture and one or two tutorials.

COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACE (CSP)*

A CSP means that the Australian government partially subsidises course fees for domestic students, and you pay a student contribution. This is a subsidy, not a loan, and you don't have to pay it back. CSPs are only available to Australian or New Zealand citizens, or to permanent humanitarian visa holders. The government allocates a limited number of CSPs to universities or other tertiary education providers.

VET COURSES

Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses equip students for practical occupations. They are different to university degrees because of their practical focus and shorter completion time. Certificates I to IV, Diplomas and Advanced Diplomas can be VET courses. Students who complete a VET course may enter the workforce or begin a university degree.
