WHAT WILL I BE STUDYING?

The MBA is a twelve-unit study program offered in two patterns. Both patterns will study core units: Theology, Theory and Practice of Leadership and Introduction to Research.

Students following Pattern 1 will complete a minimum of six units of coursework from the list below, and an independent project. Students following Pattern 2 will complete seven units of coursework from the list below, and a major research project.

- | Leadership and organisation
- | Communication for leaders
- | Organisational processes and change
- | Human Resource management
- | Managerial and professional ethics
- | Marketing management
- | Strategic planning for leadership
- | Accounting for leaders
- | Legal and governance issues for managers.

Avondale also offers optional exit points at **Graduate Certificate** (4 units) and **Graduate Diploma** (8 units) **in Leadership and Management.**

IMPORTANT PROGRAM DETAILS

Fees

Tuition fees for 2023 are A\$2,495* per unit of study for Australian and New Zealand domestic students, and A\$3,405 per unit of study for international students. Eligible domestic students can apply to defer their tuition fees to a FEE-HELP loan.

*This is the fee for a standard unit of study. Some units attract higher fees.

Program Intakes

There are two intakes a year:
February/March and July/August.

Program Duration

The MBA is a twelve-unit study program offered in two patterns. It is offered as a three-years part time and by-distance study, with an on-campus residential that may be required for some units.

Entry Requirements

Prospective Australian or New Zealand students will need to:

- | Have completed a university degree, or
- | Have completed Graduate Certificate or Diploma of Leadership and Management, and
- | Have at least two years of employment experience in a leadership and management role (the two years experience is required no matter what academic qualification is held).
