WHAT WILL I BE STUDYING?

The Master of Teaching (Secondary) is a two-year, graduate-entry degree that will prepare you to teach at the secondary school level. It is a highly practical course, with hands-on classroom experience, which will qualify and prepare you to competently teach years 7-12 in up to two different teaching areas.

The course structure is based on four semesters (each 13 weeks long), with four units of study normally completed in each semester, including:

To be eligible to study the Master of Teaching (Secondary) degree, your undergraduate degree must align with the area you intend to teach. The course convenor will assess your transcript to ensure the content requirements have been met. Students who join our degree program come as scientists, lawyers, artists, journalists and many other specialties and are driven to pursue the degree by their passion to use an area they love to help the next generation realise their full potential.

IMPORTANT PROGRAM DETAILS

Fees

Most Australian and New Zealand Master of Teaching (Primary) students receive a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) to study this degree at Avondale. A CSP means that the Australian government partially subsidises course fees and you pay a small student contribution. In 2023, the student contribution is \$515^{*} per unit of study. This is a substantial saving on the full tuition fees. Eligible domestic students can also apply to defer their fee contribution to a FEE-HELP loan.

Program Intakes

There are two intakes a year: February/March and July/August.

Program Duration

The Master of Teaching (Secondary) course consists of 16 units of study. You can choose to study full-time, over four semester or two years, or part-time equivalent.

Entry Requirements

Prospective Australian or New Zealand students will need to:

- Have a suitable Australian bachelor's degree or equivalent degree that meets the requirements of the New South Wales Education Standards Authority (NESA).
